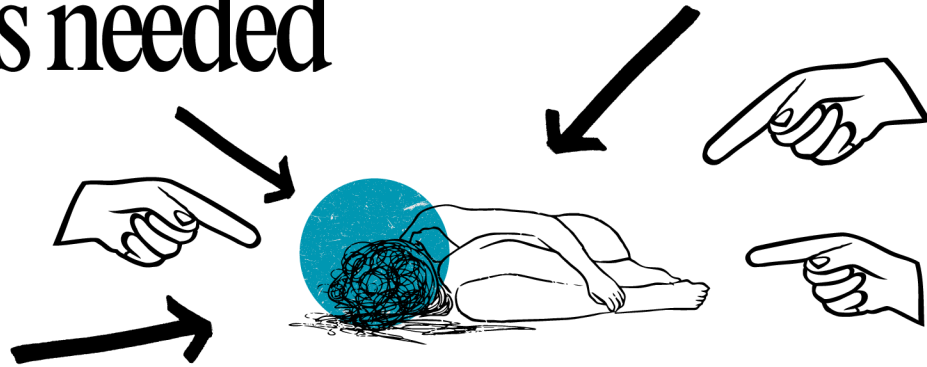


Psychotherapists with experience working with adult females who have experienced non-stranger rape - Your input is needed
